



Are You a Veteran Interested in Participating in Homeless Court at the 2011 Southeastern Michigan Veterans Stand Down???

What is a Homeless Court?

The Southeastern Michigan Veterans Stand Down Homeless Court is designed to promote access to the court and resolution to **Misdemeanor Offenses** in **DETROIT only** by meeting veterans at stand down and reconciling their misdemeanor offense with treatment programs and judicial oversight. This alternative sentencing is designed to assist the veteran with reintegration into society and provide a constructive alternative to fines and custody.

How does it work?

- Participation in Homeless Court is strictly **voluntary** and will address **DETROIT misdemeanor cases only**. Cases will be heard at the Southeastern Michigan Veterans Stand Down on **October 12 & 13, 2011**.
- Only veterans discharged from military services under conditions **other than dishonorable** will qualify.
- **Pre-registration is required for all veterans! NO EXCEPTIONS!!**
